events organised to mark the 100th anniversary of Poland regaining its independence

- January 11, 2018

The Conference on *'The History of the Eastern Borderlands. Lviv'* – prior to the Conference, a lecture hall (room 3002 located in the JDU building at Armii Krajowej 13/15) was named after a Polish mathematician in Lviv prof. Stefan Banach. Inside the lecture hall, a commemorative plaque dedicated to prof. Stefan Banach was unveiled. Another highlight of the event was an exhibition on the initiatives and the construction of the Lviv Eaglets monument which can be found in Raków, one of the districts in Czeszochowa. The whole event was organised by the academics of the Faculty of Philology and History and the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences.

- May 14, 2018

The Conference on *'Citizenship and patriotism in the 100th anniversary of Poland regaining its independence'* as part of Polonia Restituta programme: *Thinking of Poland ...*

The participants debated on Polish experiences of the past and considered the notions of citizenship and patriotism in decades to come.

- September 8, 2018

The academics of Jan Długosz University in Czeszochowa took part in the public reading of the early 20th-century classic on the annual National Reading Day held on September 8 under the patronage of the Polish Presidential Couple. Apart from celebrating reading, this year's edition commemorated the 100th anniversary of Poland regaining independence.

- September 21-22, 2018

The XIII International Conference on *'Freedom vs conformity - 100th anniversary of Polish pedagogy in reborn Poland'*

The Conference, hosted by the academics of the Department of Pedagogy (JDU), brought together researchers from Poland and abroad concerned with educational sciences. The debates focused on historical and contemporary issues on education and aimed at evaluating Polish pedagogical achievements over the last 100 years in the context of the development of educational sciences in other countries.



- October 14-16, 2018

The Conference on *'Intelligence / counterintelligence and the security of reborn Poland' (1918-1923)*

The Conference was held under the patronage of the Head of the Internal Security Agency prof. dr. hab. Piotra Pogonowski and the Rector of Jan Dlugosz University in Czestochowa prof. dr hab. Anna Wypych-Gawrońska.

- December 6-8, 2018

The Conference on *'You are our Queen. Jasna Góra and its roads to independence'*

There will be two venues of the Conference: Jan Dlugosz University and Jasna Góra Monastery. The organising committee wish to remind us of a difficult mission of frequently-forgotten artists, writers, teachers, clergymen and nuns who, through their involvement, cared to preserve national traditions and values, to draw our attention to Jasna Góra Monastery itself and its contribution in regaining our freedom, as well as to the meaning and significance of the patronage of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Czestochowa in the fight for our independence.

The conference will be accompanied by artistic events – an exhibition from the Monastery's collection, presenting artefacts related to the pursuit of Poles fighting for their country and a solemn symphonic concert during which the Overture in E-flat major for Ignacy Jan Paderewski's orchestra and Piano Concerto in E-minor by Fryderyk Chopin will be performed.
